

“Safety Town” Program Offering

“Safety Town” has a long history in St. Joseph. Starting this summer we have an opportunity to bring Safety Town to Minnie Cline Elementary School, but open to all Savannah 5 to 7 year olds, for a two week session. The first session will be June 29 through July 2 and the second session from July 6 through July 9. Sheldon Lyon, St. Joseph Safety and Health Council Executive Director, will be present to give an overview of Safety Town. The cost to the Savannah R-III School District would be \$3,500. The Safety Council has planned fund raising during the next fiscal year. It is anticipated that in future years there would be no cost to the district.

It is recommended the Board approve hosting Safety Town at Minnie Cline Elementary School this summer.
